Rabbi Isaiah Zeldin, new rabbi at Temple Israel replacing Rabbi J. Aaron Levy, now an Army chaplain in Manila, will speak tonight at 8 o'clock on "Can the Atomic Bomb Guarantee Peace?"

During the service traditional Jewish melodies will be presented, Walter Perl, organist.

Rabbi Zeldin is a senior student at the Hebrew Union College, Cincinnati, O., and will preside here for a year as a licensed rabbi after which he will be ordained.

His father, Morris Zeldin, is director of the United Jewish Appeal, which seeks \$64,000,000 for overseas relief, restoration of Palestine and Refugee Service in the United States.

Rabbi Zeldin speaks Hebrew fluently. He and his wife are domiciled at Hotel Stockton until they can find a home.
